

SURVIVE & THRIVE PROGRAM

Australian Red Cross Society

To address food insecurity through the continuation of two Good Start Breakfast Clubs at Northern Bay College. \$30,000

Bellarine Living and Learning Centre

To improve and expand the foodbank operation from 750 kg to 1250+ kg of food distributed per week supporting the needs of over 500+ people each week. \$30,000

Drysdale Family Support

To improve the food security and the health and wellbeing of residents on the Bellarine Peninsula through the operation of a foodbank service and subsidised counselling services. \$30,000

Geelong Food Relief Centre

To improve food security by providing adequate fresh, nutritious and relevant food to families who are experiencing disadvantage. \$30,000

Geelong Mums

To improve the safety, health and wellbeing of babies and young children through the provision of emergency relief nursery equipment like cots/mattresses, prams and car seats as well as other essential items like clothing, linen, nappies, formula and feeding equipment. \$30,000

Samaritan House Geelong

To address homelessness by providing overnight crisis accommodation and ongoing support at Samaritan House Geelong for homeless men aged over 18 years. \$30,000

SecondBite

To provide vulnerable women, men and children who are struggling to feed themselves with free and regular access to quality fresh nutritious food through the organisation's food rescue and redistribution service. \$30,000

The Haven Foundation

To establish long term supported accommodation for people who have a severe and enduring mental illness and who are at risk of homelessness. \$75,000

The Outpost

To meet the immediate needs of those experiencing crisis circumstances; including the homeless, single parent families, and increasingly, the working poor, through the provision of meals, and material aid. \$25,000

UnitingCare Geelong

To provide housing assistance to those who are homeless or at risk of homelessness. \$30,000

Urban Seed

To address the root causes of food insecurity, through the operation of the 'Neighbourhood Kitchen', 'People's Pantry' and programs to educate and empower families to develop food security plans in Norlane. \$30,000
